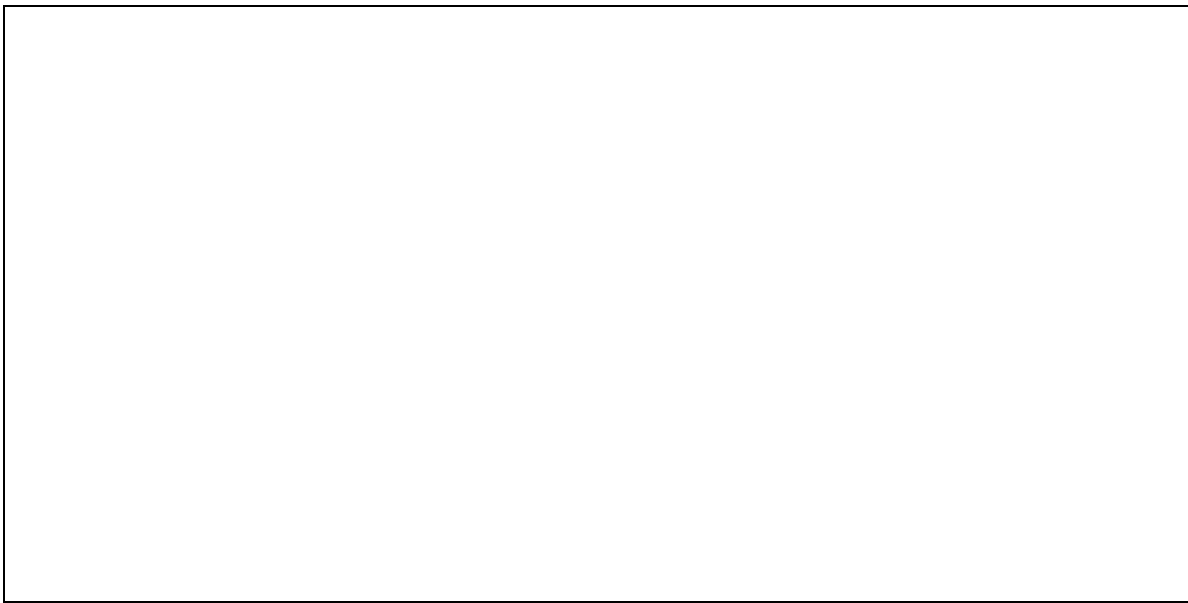

**NOTE:** Any enclosure, building, structure or hen house that will be brought onto or built on the property for the use of keeping chickens must first apply for and be issued a zoning permit, AND, where applicable, a flood plain permit.

Property Owner and/Tenant (if applicable) agree:

- All requirements of this permit and any zoning/floodplain permit requirements must be met PRIOR to the issuance of a chicken permit.
- All chicken permits will be issued on a first-come, first-serve basis given that ALL permit application requirements are met
- The maximum number of chickens that will be kept under conditions of this permit will not exceed 6 chickens, (chickens include but not limited to hens, roasters, Cornish, chicks, ect.) Maximum of 6 in any combination, no roosters.
- That NO roosters will be allowed
- Only one permit shall be issued per lot
- That all chickens shall be contained within the permittee's property boundary at all times.
- Chickens shall be provided with a cover, predator-proof hen house that is thoroughly ventilated and of sufficient size to admit free movement of the chickens.
- The hen house must be adjacent to and provide free access to the chicken enclosure.
- Any heat sources or electrical facilities installed in a hen house must comply with all adopted building and electrical code of the State of Montana.
- Chickens shall be secured within the enclosure from sunset to sunrise
- Chicken enclosures and houses must be kept in a neat and sanitary condition at all times and must be cleaned on a regular basis so as to prevent offensive odors
- Storage of chicken manure must be in a fully enclosed bin/container as to prevent offensive odors
- Chickens shall have continuous access to adequate food and water
- Feed must be kept in rodent and predator-proof containers
- Chickens shall be maintained in a healthy condition. Ill chickens shall receive medical care or be culled
