proposed landscaping and location of all signs plus items required in the Ordinance specific to what the CUP is requesting. The lack of any of the required information will delay this application.

IMPORTANT:

- Per Zoning and Planning By-Laws Article 9 section C-6: Failure to attend public hearings will result in postponement of the hearing. You must attend in person, via zoom or have a representative attend both Zoning and Planning Hearing and City Council Hearing.
- 2) All Statements of explanation and mitigation of use, size, employees, signage, etc. presented in this application are made conditions of approval, if approved.
- 3) If there are any CHANGES to this application after the Zoning Board Hearing, that are not requested by the Zoning Board, the applicant will be required to submit a new application and fee.
- 4) Inspection Requirement
 - a. Any Conditional Use Permit approved under this title shall at all times be subject to inspection by city officials (Zoning official, City Employee, or person(s) designated by the Mayor), to insure conformity with approval and details in the application.
 - b. The business licensee and/or employees of such licensee shall at all times allow the zoning compliance officer to enter the premises for inspection of any licensed activity, if applicable.
- 5) Compliance Certificate (provided with approval letter with conditions) is required to be signed and returned within 10 days of CUP completion, certifying all conditions have been met, before opening or use.

*Permit Reviews often have professional services and/or special meetings that staff utilizes to ensure adherence to Zoning, Floodplain or Legal requirements. These are not included in the permit fee paid at time of submittal. However, Ord. #11-20-1(A) allows for the City to submit an invoice to the applicant/property owner for the reimbursement of reasonable expenses from professional services.

City of Three Forks,

Please accept this as an update to our current Conditional Use Permit.

We are presenting this for consideration of year-round rental of the cabins located on our property. This is for the cabins only and not the RV hookups. We did not understand we could have proposed this on our initial Conditional Use Application. Much has transpired since conception. We underwent many hurdles and costs that we did not fully understand would be needed. Some examples are: DEQ requirements, Zoning requirements, Floodplain requirements, Main Extensions, extended timeline to completion causing for additional labor costs alone with loss of income, along with many others. When put into actual dollars, it is extensive.

In an effort to help bring those to speed that were not on the Counsil at the time of the original Conditional Use Application I will share how we got to where we are. Initially you will see we were looking for a way to offer a place for friends and family to park their RV's while they visit. And, we looked to enjoy our living structures mostly for personal use. We were informed, at that time, that RV's could not be occupied while connected to a structure. As I understand it, this is not enforced in the same way now. Regardless, we asked what we could do and were informed a small camping facility would be good. What we have since learned is it was much more of an undertaking than we understood. Both in time and cost. Because of the large amount of unexpected expenses, we are now requesting annual rental of the cabins in an effort to offset upfront building costs along with ongoing costs to operate. Please note, in our opinion and that shared by others in the community, we have truly updated, cleaned up, and in fact added to the appeal of this part of Three Forks.

Since there is not any conflict with any other locations or Conditional Use Permits, we would now like the opportunity to rent our cabins on an annual basis. This will allow our cabins to align with other rentals in the City of Three Forks that are able to be rented on an annual basis. We see this as an opportunity not only for us but also for the City of Three Forks businesses as more revenue from guests will be brought to the community.

Our property is located at 126 E. Jefferson St.

 We are submitting an application for year-round rental of our cabins. Cabins are all surveyed out of any flood plain restrictions and certified/approved to rent.
